Bulk trash is a service provided free-of-charge to current water account users in residential zoning areas during Georgia Cities Week. Annual pick-up will start on **Monday, April 22nd, 2024**, and will continue throughout the week.

Curbside pick-up will include large items such as appliances, furniture, and other bulky items not normally picked up by the regular trash service. All City residents should place their items on the curb by 7 a.m. the morning of the scheduled pick-up.

This annual event is hosted by the City of Richmond Hill and the Fort McAllister Sport Fishing Club.


