



## FALLEN HEROES MEMORIAL

Each year, our Memorial Day ceremony is held to honor the brave men and women who have made the ultimate sacrifice for our country. This year, we unveiled our new Fallen Heroes Memorial in J.F. Gregory Park.

The Fallen Heroes Memorial features a battlefield cross composed of a rifle, helmet, boots, and dog tags. The downward facing rifle with a helmet perched on top symbolizes a service member killed in action; the boots signify their march to battle; and the dog tags mean that they are never to be forgotten.

Alongside the statue, plaques honor four fallen soldiers from Richmond Hill who have lost their lives in service to their country:

- Sergeant Harry Lee Boles, United States Army;
- Sergeant Lowry Taylor Cuthbert, United States Army;
- Captain Matthew C.H. Freeman, United States Marine Corps;
- Petty Officer Third Class Cameron Scott Walters, United States Navy;

We encourage you to stop by the monument and take a moment to pay tribute to these fallen heroes.

## GARBAGE & RECYCLING REMINDERS

**ALL carts must be:** 5 ft away from cars/mailboxes, 3 feet between containers and placed with **wheels against the curb** facing forward.

**Household Garbage:** **ALL** garbage should be bagged and the cart lid **must** be fully closed. No bags may be placed beside or on top of the cart.

**Recycling:** **ALL** items may be co-mingled. No plastic bags should be placed in recycling. Paper bags are acceptable.


Mosquitoes are more than just a nuisance; they can carry dangerous diseases such as West Nile virus, Zika virus, and Eastern Equine Encephalitis.

## HURRICANE TIPS

4. **Stay Informed:** Sign up for our emergency alert system **CodeRed**.

6. **Stay Informed:** Monitor local weather updates and follow instructions from authorities.
7. **Fuel Up:** Make sure your car's gas tank is full, and have extra fuel for generators.
8. **Backup Power:** Consider a generator for power outages and know how to use it safely

Did you know that you can report issues online with **SeeClickFix**?

SeeClickFix is an online portal that makes it simple to report everything from potholes to code violations and more.

Visit our website ([richmondhill-ga.gov](http://richmondhill-ga.gov)) and click on "SeeClickFix Requests," or download the SeeClickFix app on the App Store or Google Play.

To submit a report, just snap a pic and complete a ticket with the location and description of the issue. Residents can even report issues anonymously!

Upon completion, your report will be forwarded to the appropriate City department. Follow along on the progress of the report and receive notifications of the resolution.
