Eligible items include:

- No cardboard boxes or trash bags.
- Restricted items will not be collected.

FLOOD PREPAREDNESS

Richmond Hill has several low-lying coastal plain areas that are vulnerable to flooding from rivers and canals. Understanding your flood risk and taking proactive steps can help protect your home and community.

Know your flood hazard! Review the flood zone map and determine if your property is in a flood zone. Learn your neighborhood's Base Flood Elevation (BFE). Contact the City of Richmond Hill Department of Planning & Zoning at (912) 756-3641 for questions.

Purchase flood insurance. Standard homeowner's insurance does not cover flood damage. The City of Richmond Hill participates in the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP), allowing local insurance agents to provide federally backed flood insurance at subsidized rates. Protect your home by purchasing a policy.

Protect your property. Reduce flood damage by taking preventive measures like elevating electrical panels, heat pumps, washers and dryers above flood levels.



Flood Warning System. The Bryan County Emergency Management Agency (BEMA) manages the local flood warning system. Stay informed by following BEMA's social media for emergency alerts and preparedness information.

Drainage. Prevent flooding by keeping drainage systems free of debris. Do not sweep or blow yard waste into streets or storm drains. Dumping in ditches is prohibited under the City's Stormwater Management Ordinance. If your property is next to a drainage ditch, help by keeping the area clear of debris.
